210 Day Work Calendar ** Updated 8-15-22

Keep in mind that if you return to work on one of the following days and work straight through, your finish date would be the corresponding date.

Start - Finish

August 1, 2022 - June 21, 2023

August 2 - June 22nd

August 3 – June 23rd

August 4 - June 26th

August 5 - June 27th

August 8 - June 28th

August 9 - June 29th

August 10 - June 30th

*Principals and Assistant Principals, we are on the same team, so please work together to ensure that we minimize confusion about the work calendar.

*There are actually 210 school work days between

August 1, 2022 and June 21, 2022.

*There are 7 more available work days between June 22nd and June 30th, which brings the total available work days to 217 and allows AP's staggered start and end dates.

DON'T FORGET: AP's are only required to work 210 Days!!

*The other thing to remember is, if you work any portion of any Saturday or Sunday, you must include those days in your 210 day count. That means any weekend sports event or other school event that you cover.
